Hearing Examiner Rules on Point Wells Developer's Motion to Reconsider

The Snohomish County Hearing Examiner (HE) has ruled on BSRE's motion to reconsider the HE's decision to deny BSRE's application for a 3,000 unit development at Point Wells. The HE rejected most of BSRE's arguments agreeing only that BSRE could appeal the decision to the County Council before going to Superior Court, and agreeing that the application was denied without prejudice. BSRE may try to use the denial without prejudice to claim they can retain their Urban Center development rights, but the county is expected to say that any new application must follow the current Urban Village development rules, which give Shoreline more control over the size of the development.
