

Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements are coming to your street!

In 2008, the City of Shoreline completed the Interurban Trail that runs north and south through the City. While this provides a valuable connection for users traveling north/south through Shoreline, it is missing connections to local neighborhoods, parks, city amenities and schools. The Bike Plan Implementation project will complete the majority of the City of Shoreline's adopted Bicycle System Plan and Wayfinding Program. The Bicycle Master Plan contained within the 2011 Shoreline Transportation Master Plan includes these routes. *(See attached map for route alignments)*

What is happening to 8th Ave NW?

The project will install continuous bike lanes along the corridor. This will be accomplished by installing new markings from NW Richmond Beach Road to 244th St SW.

What will construction look like?

Construction impacts include, but are not limited to:

- Disturbances to landscaping and paving within the right-of-way
- Temporary loss of two-way traffic (all work to be completed between the hours of 9am-3pm)
- Parking impacts

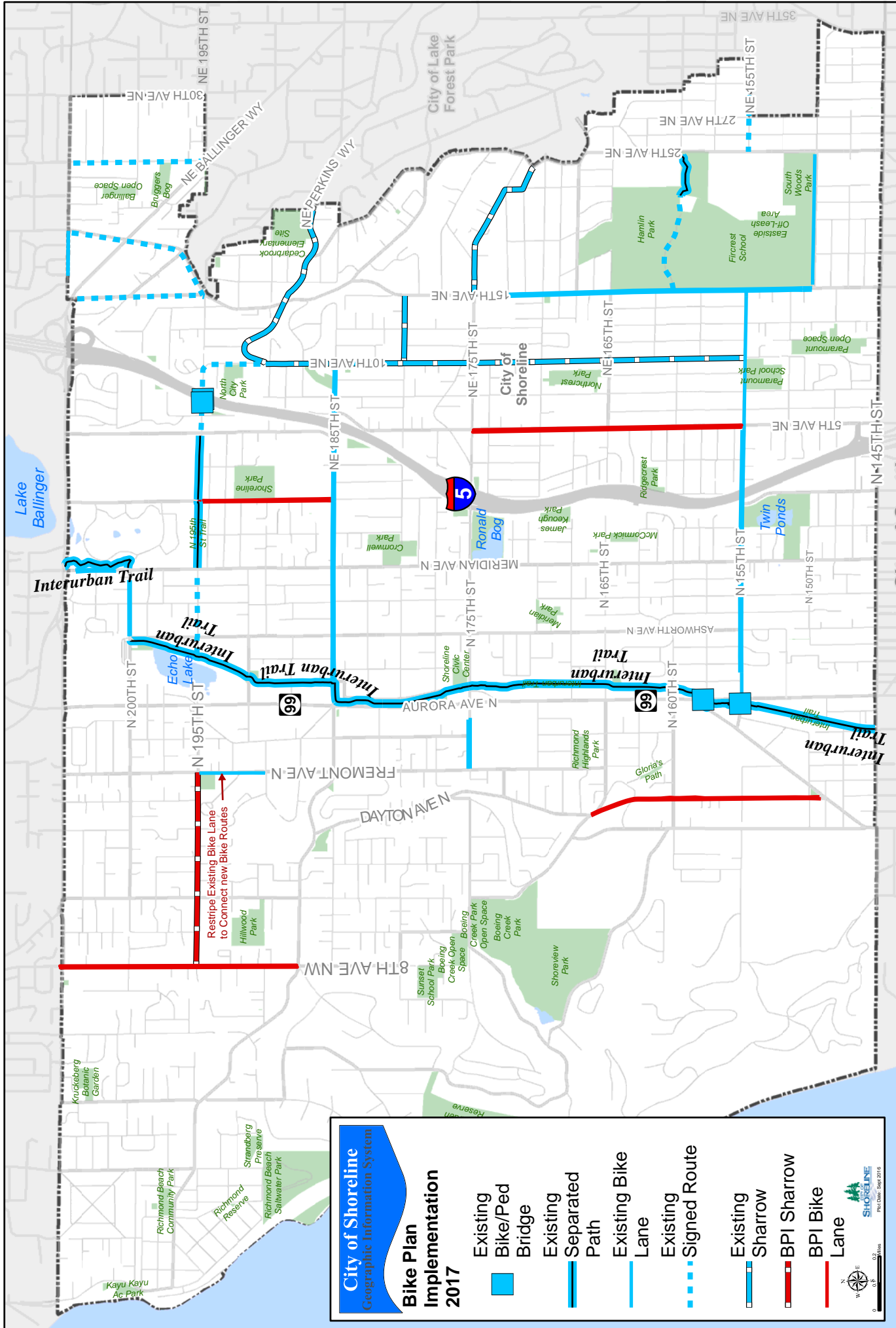
Construction is currently scheduled to begin mid-July
